A few sandwich making tips:

- \*Anyone and any age can make sandwiches.

- \*Wash your hands and the surface you will be preparing the sandwiches on.

There is no need to wear gloves.

- \*Bag each sandwich and place them upright in a paper bag or box as shown in the photo.



- \*There is no right or wrong way to make a sandwich! We use an electric mixer to blend the peanut butter and jelly together. This makes it WAY easier (and faster) to spread on the bread. We also use the end slices if they are sturdy.

- \*If you like, you may write a positive message on the sandwich bags (Have a nice day, God Bless, etc.). Our kids make a small drawing with sharpies or place a sticker on the bags.

- \*For every 2 loaves (20 slices each) of bread you will need 24oz of peanut butter and 16oz of jelly and 20 sandwich bags.

Casa Maria serves 400 people EVERY DAY, offering a hot meal and sack lunch. ANYONE can get a meal at CM and there is always a need, more so now than ever, for volunteers and donations.
